sufficient to allow the payment of statutory dues, and not for any other purpose.

Liberty is granted to Respondent No.2 to file a detailed reply on behalf of Respondent

No.2 & 3 with a copy in advance to the counsel for the Petitioner. Let needful be done

within three weeks. Rejoinder, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter with a copy in

advance to the counsel opposite.

belonging to this case to Delhi within ten days.
