ORDER


Petition mentioned.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner states that by illegally convened EGM dated 28.01.2016 the shareholding of the Petitioner has been reduced from 49.64% to 43.15% and inter-aila argued that he has lost control over the Respondent No.1-company by virtue of reduction of share in the related C.P. No.51/MB/2016 from 90% to 3.54%.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner has also pointed out that the service on respondents have been effected. However, none has preferred to put in appearance.

Respondent may file their reply within four weeks with a copy in advance to the counsel for the petitioner. Rejoinder if any be filed within two weeks thereafter with a copy in advance to the counsel for the Respondent. In the meanwhile and till the next date of hearing the shareholding of the Petitioner shall not be reduced any further and no encumbrance is created on any fixed assets of the company in the form of mortgage, lease, collateral security or in any other manner whatsoever.
