not the list of properties, if really R2 &3 agrees to clear the dues of the petitioner, R2 & R3 should come with a concrete agreement showing way out for realizing Rs. 100/- Crores or the amount agreeable to the petitioner, within four days i.e. before 10.11.2014.

Or else the petitioner counsel submits the petitioner will pray before this Bench for hearing and disposal of the Company Petition filed by it.

On which R-2 counsel and R-3 counsel have categorically stated that they will have a sitting with the petitioner on 8.11.2014 at Mumbai to get the issue resolved.

If no settlement has taken place as said by the Respondents, the matter will come up for hearing before CLB Chennai on 11.11.2014.

On the request made by R-2 & R-3 counsel, the lists given by the Respondents are taken on record without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the respondents herein and this proposal is also without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the petitioner as well.
